

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE  
STATE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE**

**LCB File No. R097-99**

Effective January 1, 2000

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 586.406; §2, NRS 588.210; §3, NRS 590.380; §4, NRS.561.105.

**Section 1.** Chapter 586 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

*Each person registering to sell restricted-use pesticides shall pay an annual registration fee of \$25.*

**Sec. 2.** Chapter 588 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

*1. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 588.210 and 588.215 and NAC 588.030, a person who offers for sale, sells or distributes in this state commercial fertilizers or agricultural minerals, or both, shall pay to the department the following fees:*

*(a) For quarterly sales or distribution of commercial fertilizers of 20 tons or more, 25 cents per ton; and*

*(b) For agricultural minerals:*

*(1) If sold in packages, for quarterly sales or distribution of 20 tons or more, 25 cents per ton; and*

*(2) If sold in bulk, for quarterly sales or distribution of 100 tons or more, 5 cents per ton.*

*2. No fees are required to be paid for quarterly sales or distribution of commercial fertilizers or agricultural minerals in quantities smaller than those established in subsection 1.*

**Sec. 3.** Chapter 590 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

*A manufacturer, packer, seller or distributor of antifreeze shall pay an inspection fee of \$50 for each brand of antifreeze submitted to the state sealer of weights and measures for inspection pursuant to NRS 590.380.*

**Sec. 4.** This regulation becomes effective on January 1, 2000.
