PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE DIVISION OF STATE PARKS OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF

CONSERVATION AND NATURAL RESOURCES

EXPLANATION - Matter in italics is new; matter in brackets [fomitted material] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §§1-9, NRS 407.0475 and 407.065.

- **Section 1.** Chapter 407 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 and 3 of this regulation.
- Sec. 2. Within Cave Lake State Park, a person shall not camp for more than 7 days in a 30-day period.
- Sec. 3. Within Rye Patch State Recreation Area, a person shall not swim, wade or engage in other aquatic sports in the area of the spillway of the dam.
 - **Sec. 4.** NAC 407.0063 is hereby amended to read as follows:

407.0063 "Boating" means the operation of a watercraft which is:

- 1. Launched or set adrift from a state park; and
- 2. Propelled by machinery or [not less than 10 feet in length.] transported into the park by trailer.
 - **Sec. 5.** NAC 407.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 407.050 1. [A] The division will issue a permit for senior citizens to a resident of Nevada who [is 60] applies for such a permit if the resident:

- (a) Is 65 years of age or older [and applies for a permit for senior citizens will be issued such a permit without charge upon furnishing];
- (b) Has continuously resided in this state for the 5 years immediately preceding the date on which the resident submits the application;
 - (c) Pays a \$10 administrative fee; and
 - (d) **Provides** proof of his age and residence in Nevada : to the division.

A permit for senior citizens authorizes the holder to enter, camp in and boat in all parks. [The division will accept as proof of the age and residence of an applicant, a certificate of registration for a vehicle issued to the applicant by the department of motor vehicles and public safety and:

- (a) A driver's license; or
- (b) An identification card which matches the registration for the vehicle,

- 2. The division will charge and collect the following fees:

- 3. The division will charge and collect for using any commercial vehicle, including, without limitation, a bus, in any park, \$1 per person or the entrance fee for the park, whichever is greater, or the fee established by a special use permit. A special use permit may provide for monthly billings.
- 4. Before a person may engage in commercial photography in a park, he must apply for and obtain a permit from the division that authorizes him to do so. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 5, for each day or partial day that a person engages in commercial photography in a park, the division will charge and collect the following fee according to the total number of vehicles or the total number of persons, whichever results in a higher fee:

The division will waive the entrance fee for the park upon payment of the fee for commercial photography.

- 5. The division will not charge a fee pursuant to this section for :
- (a) Commercial photography engaged in by one person; or
- (b) Photography engage in for noncommercial, educational purposes, to promote the park or to report news in any form of media, including, without limitation, newspapers and television.
- 6. If a user of a park does not deposit the required fee in the available self-service devices, the division will charge the user a fee of \$2 for collection service, in addition to other fees.
- 7. For each special use permit, the division will charge a processing fee of \$25 in addition to any other fee charged for the permit.
 - **Sec. 6.** NAC 407.055 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 407.055 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 1 of NAC 407.050 and in NAC 407.052, or unless waived, the division will charge and collect the following fees for the use of parks:

- 2. A person who pays an entrance fee pursuant to subsection 1 is not authorized to use the facilities of the park from 10 p.m. until 6 a.m. unless he also pays the boating or camping fee for the park.
- 3. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the division will charge and collect from each person who rides a bicycle or horse or who walks into a park an entrance fee of \$1. The division will charge and collect from each person who rides a bicycle into Spooner Management Area an entrance fee of \$2.
- 4. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the division will not charge a fee for any vehicle that is towed into a park. If a person tows more than one vehicle into a park, the division will charge a fee for each additional vehicle towed into the park.
- 5. The division will charge, in addition to any other fee imposed pursuant to this chapter, a fee of:
- (a) Three dollars per day for each rental of a boat slip at Cave Lake State Park or Spring Valley State Park; [and]

- (b) Six dollars for each boat anchored overnight in Sand Harbor ∃; and
- (c) Two dollars for each watercraft in excess of two that is transported into the park by a single vehicle and pursuant to a single boating permit.
 - **Sec. 7.** NAC 407.105 is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 407.105 1. In any park, a person shall not:
 - (a) Use a bow and arrow, slingshot or paint ball launcher;
 - (b) Possess a firearm, unless it is unloaded and inside a vehicle;
 - (c) Discharge a weapon, including, without limitation, an air rifle, spring gun or air pistol; or
 - (d) Throw a knife, hatchet, spear, stone or projectile,

except as authorized by the administrator.

- 2. The administrator may designate zones in which a person may, for the purposes of hunting [], a species that is designated by the board of wildlife commissioners as a game mammal or game bird pursuant to chapter 503 of NAC, carry and discharge a firearm or bow in accordance with the regulations of the division of wildlife of the state department of conservation and natural resources. At each park in which a zone is designated pursuant to this subsection, the ranger in charge of the region or the supervisor of the park shall post at the headquarters of the park, and at each area within the park which is designated as a zone in which a person may carry and discharge a firearm or bow for the purposes of hunting, maps of the designated zones within that park.
- 3. Target shooting is prohibited in all areas of a park, except in an area designated as a firing range.
 - **Sec. 8.** NAC 407.260 is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 407.260 Within the Floyd R. Lamb State Park, a person shall not:

- 1. Swim, wade, or engage in other aquatic sports, except fishing, in any lake;
- 2. Swim, wade, or engage in other aquatic sports or loiter in or near any irrigation canal;
- 3. Play baseball, softball, golf, or pitch horseshoes on the grass;
- 4. Use any area for a musical concert without the permission of the supervisor of the park;
- 5. Operate a powered model boat or aircraft within the park, except as authorized by the supervisor of the park;
 - 6. Use a powered or nonpowered boat on a lake;
- 7. Operate a bicycle or skateboard in excess of a reasonable speed or otherwise in a manner that jeopardizes the safety of others; or
 - 8. Bring a group of more than [50] 25 persons into the park without a group reservation.
 - **Sec. 9.** NAC 407.320 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 407.320 Within [Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area and] Spring Mountain Ranch State Park, no person may:
 - 1. Leave a vehicle or equipment overnight in an area restricted to use during the day;
- 2. Operate a public address system, loud speaker, or amplifier without the approval of the supervisor of the park; or
 - 3. Play baseball, softball, or golf or pitch horseshoes on the grass.
