

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION**

LCB File No. R188-99

Effective March 13, 2000

AUTHORITY: §§1-3, NRS 233B.050, 385.391 and 391.165.

Section 1. Chapter 391 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 and 3 of this regulation.

Sec. 2. *To assist licensed teachers in making a determination regarding their eligibility for the benefit provided by NRS 391.165:*

1. The department will, on or before April 15 of each year, notify each school district of the schools in the school district that have been designated as demonstrating need for improvement pursuant to NRS 385.363 and 385.367.

2. Each school district shall:

(a) Notify all licensed teachers who are employed in that school district by a school that has been designated as demonstrating need for improvement pursuant to NRS 385.363 and 385.367 of that designation; and

(b) Upon request of any teacher licensed in this state, provide to that teacher a list of all schools within the school district that have been designated as demonstrating need for improvement pursuant to NRS 385.363 and 385.367.

Sec. 3. 1. *The department interprets the term “licensed teacher,” as used in NRS 391.165, to include a licensed teacher who works at more than one school, but who spends at least 50 percent of all the hours he spends teaching in a school year at one or more schools that have been designated as demonstrating need for improvement pursuant to NRS 385.363 and 385.367.*

2. The requirement set forth in paragraph (d) of subsection 1 of NRS 391.165 is satisfied only if the school year during which the licensed teacher is to be employed by the school that has been designated as demonstrating need for improvement commences after the designation has been made by the department pursuant to NRS 385.363 and 385.367.
