**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS**

NRS 41.036(6) provides that the State Board of Examiners shall adopt regulations specifying the type of claim that the Attorney General is required to approve, settle or deny a claim and the procedure to be used by the Attorney General in disposing of that claim. The following language is to be included in chapter 41 of NAC.

*41.200 The Attorney General:*

*1. Shall investigate all tort claims and tort appeals against the state, its agencies, boards, officers, employees or immune contractors.*

*2. May deny any tort claim or appeal against the state, its agencies, boards, officers, employees or immune contractors.*

*3. May settle any tort claim or tort appeal against the state, its agencies, boards, officers, employees or immune contractors in the amount of \$25,000 or less.*

*4. Shall present any tort claim or tort appeal against the state, its agencies, boards, officers, employees or immune contractors greater than \$25,000 to the state board of examiners for approval.*
