**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
STATE ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION
PETITION 2000-07**

EXPLANATION - Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets ~~[omitted material]~~ is material to be omitted.

Authority: NRS 445B.210 and 445B.770

Section 1. Chapter 445B of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 to 3, inclusive, of this regulation.

Sec. 2. *(Certified on-board diagnostic system” defined.) “Certified on-board diagnostic system” means a computer system housed within the vehicle and certified by the United States Environmental Protection Agency to be fully capable of monitoring all of the sensors and actuators in the vehicle’s drive train to determine whether they are working as intended.*

Sec. 3. *(Inspection of vehicle: On-board diagnostic (OBD) checks required.)*

1. Any 1996 and newer model year motor vehicle which is equipped with a certified on-board diagnostic system and subject to inspection in accordance with the provisions of chapter 445B of NRS, as a condition of compliance with the inspection, must undergo an OBD system inspection beginning January 1, 2001.

2. The department shall develop test procedures and certify equipment to be used for the OBD system inspection.
