**INFORMATIONAL STATEMENT**

The following statement is submitted for temporary adopted amendments to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 624 that adds a subclassification for the installation of photovoltaics to the C2 Electrical Contracting license classification C-2 and adds a fee for the review of an application filed pursuant to an entity conversion.

**1. A description of how public comment was solicited, a summary of public response, and an explanation how other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.**

A workshop and hearing were noticed on February 25, 2003 by posting at the Washoe County Court House; Washoe County Library; Reno City Hall; Las Vegas City Hall; Sawyer State Building; Clark County Library and Offices of the Contractors' Board in Reno and Las Vegas. The notice was posted on the agency's website and mailed to approximately 135 interested individuals.

**3. A description of how comment was solicited from affected businesses, a summary of their response, and an explanation how other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.**

Comments were solicited from affected businesses by the notice posting, website and direct mail.

**4. If the regulation was adopted without changing any part of the proposed regulation, a summary of the reasons for adopting the regulation without change.**

The regulation was adopted by the Nevada State Contractors Board at its April 8, 2003 meeting with minor change after receiving written comment.

**5. The estimated economic effect of the adopted regulation on the business which it is to regulate and on the public. These must be stated separately, and each case must include:**

(a) The proposed revisions are expected to have little economic impact on the regulated industry since the regulation simply adds a subclassification to existing classifications and we do not anticipate a large number of entity conversion review applications.

(b) Immediate and long-term effects should be minimal.

**6. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the adopted regulation.**

The cost of enforcement of the proposed regulation will be minimal.
