**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE STATE BOARD
OF ARCHITECTURE, INTERIOR DESIGN
AND RESIDENTIAL DESIGN**

Chapter 623 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

NAC 623.____ Credit for residential designer education or training. An applicant for residential design registration must have a combination of at least five years of education and training; a minimum of one year must be in education and a minimum of one year must be in training. An applicant may acquire credit for education and training only under the following table:
