NOTICE OF WORKSHOPS TO SOLICIT COMMENTS ON PROPOSED REGULATION

The Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance (Division), is proposing new regulations pertaining to reports regarding defective products; defining the fees, reports, and penalties applicable to nonprofit hospitals, medical or dental service corporations; and the 2001 CSO Mortality Table for life insurance. A workshop has been set for 9:00 a.m., on September 30, 2004, at the offices of the Division, 788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701. Interested parties may also participate through a simultaneous video-conference conducted at the Bradley Building, 2501 East Sahara Avenue, Manufactured Housing Division Conference Room, 2nd Floor, Las Vegas, Nevada 89104. The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics addressed in the proposed regulations.

- 1. R140-04: Reports from insurers regarding defective products and defining the requirements for nonprofit hospitals or medical or dental service corporations subject to the provisions of chapter 695B of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS). The proposed regulation will amend chapter 690B of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) by requiring the reports regarding defective products to be submitted to a statistical organization designated by the Commissioner. This annual report is required by NRS 686B.060. The proposed regulation will also amend chapter 695B of the NAC by specifying the fees, reports, statements, and penalties required by those institutions subject to chapter 695B of NRS.
- 2. R113-04: 2001 CSO Mortality Table for Life Insurance. The proposed regulation adds a new section to chapter 688 A of the NAC. The new section provides for adoption, by reference, the 2001 CSO Mortality Table for Use in Determining Minimum Reserve Liabilities and Nonforfeiture Benefits Model Regulation. The proposed regulation applies to all life insurers doing business in this state.

Notice of Hearing for the Adoption of Regulations of the Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance

The Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance (Division), will hold a public hearing at 9:00 a.m., on September 30, 2004, immediately following a public workshop, at the offices of the Division, 788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701. Interested persons may also participate through a simultaneous video-conference conducted at the Bradley Building, 2501 East Sahara Avenue, Manufactured Housing Division Conference Room, 2nd Floor, Las Vegas, Nevada 89104. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption of:

PROPOSED REGULATION REGARDING 2001 CSO MORTALITY TABLE FOR LIFE INSURANCE

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

- 1. This regulation adds a new section to chapter 688A of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). The new section provides for adoption by reference the 2001 CSO Mortality Table for Use In Determining Minimum Reserve Liabilities and Nonforfeiture Benefits Model Regulation. The proposed regulation applies to all life insurers doing business in this state.
- 2. The purpose of this regulation is to recognize, permit, and prescribe the use of the 2001 Commissioners Standard Ordinary (CSO) Mortality Table.
- 3. The proposed regulation amends chapter 688A of the NAC by requiring that all life insurance policies be issued using the methodology proposed by this regulation.
- 4. Estimated economic effect of the regulation:
 - On the business which it is to regulate:
 - The proposed regulation should have no economic impact on the industry regulated. On the public:
 - The proposed regulation should have no economic impact on the public.
- 5. The Division may incur some additional expense to enforce the proposed regulation that cannot be measured at this time.
- 6. The Division is not aware of any overlap or duplication of the regulation with any state, local or federal regulation.
- 7. The proposed regulation is not pursuant to federal law.
- 8. There are no federal regulations regarding these activities.

9. The proposed regulation does not establish any new fees or increase an existing fee.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Division may appear at the scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to the Division, 788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701. Written submissions must be received by the Division on or before September 23, 2004. PROPOSED REGULATION REGARDING 2001 CSO MORTALITY TABLE FOR LIFE INSURANCE

AUTHORITY: §§NRS 679B.130, 681B.110, 681B.120, 688A.325

Section 1. Chapter 688A of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

Adoption by reference of model regulation for valuation of life insurance policies. 1. A life insurer doing business in this state shall use the 2001 CSO Mortality Table for Use In Determining Minimum Reserve Liabilities and Nonforfeiture Benefits Model Regulation adopted by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners in December 2002, which is hereby adopted by reference.
