COMMISSION GENERAL REGULATION 328

EXPLANATION: Allows for a temporary operating permit for undocumented vessels. Allows for a temporary operating permit for owners of vessels who have applied for a marine document issued by the United States Coast Guard for a documented vessel.

Section 1. NAC 488.170 is hereby amended to read as follows:

488.170. *1.* The Department or a boat dealer authorized by the Department may issue a dealer's report of motorboat sale and a 10-day temporary operating permit *for an undocumented vessel* which is valid only on the waters of this State.

2. The Department may issue a temporary operating permit not to exceed 180 days which is valid only on the waters of this State to vessel owners who have applied for and are awaiting approval of a marine document issued by the United States Coast Guard for a documented vessel.

(a) The vessel owner must provide the Department with a copy of the pending application for a marine document issued by the United States Coast Guard for a documented vessel which includes a physical description of the vessel, including the hull identification number.

(b) The vessel owner must present the valid marine document issued by the United States Coast Guard for a documented vessel to the Department before the Department will issue a certificate of number and validation decal.

1. The need for and purpose of the proposed regulation: (Description of regulation)
The United States Coast Guard has a backlog for processing the necessary paperwork for boats that are to be documented. Without the documentation papers, boat owners who have applied for US Coast Guard documentation cannot register with the Department of Wildlife. The proposed regulation would allow for a temporary operating permit to allow boat owners who have applied but not received the documentation paperwork to use their boats in the interim.
