

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
STATE CONTRACTORS' BOARD**

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 624.100 and 624.112.

A REGULATION relating to the State Contractors' Board; revising the qualifications for compliance investigators employed by the Board; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 624.135 is hereby amended to read as follows:

624.135 Each person who is employed by the Board as a compliance investigator must have:

1. A valid certificate in construction skills issued by ~~[the International Conference of Building Officials or]~~ a nationally recognized organization ~~[that adopts building codes which have been adopted by the State of Nevada or a local government in this State; and~~

~~—2.— One of the following:~~

2. A high school diploma and at least 4 years of progressively responsible experience performing field investigations;

3. A high school diploma and ~~[have]~~ at least 4 years of experience in the construction industry as a contractor, journeyman, foreman or supervising employee, or the equivalent thereof, as determined by the Board;

~~[(b)]~~ 4. A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a major in preengineering, construction inspection or construction technology, or a related area of study as determined by the Board, and ~~[(have)]~~ at least 3 years of experience in the construction industry as a contractor, journeyman, foreman or supervising employee, or the equivalent thereof, as determined by the Board; or

~~[(e)]~~ 5. Any sufficient combination of education and experience as determined by the Board.
