

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE  
STATE LIBRARY AND ARCHIVES ADMINISTRATOR**

**LCB File No. R089-06**

Effective June 1, 2006

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 380.153.

A REGULATION relating to libraries; amending the list of legal books and materials that must be available in each county; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Section 1.** NAC 380.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:

380.010 The following legal books and materials are considered primary sources and are required by law to be available , *in print or electronic form*, in every county to the inhabitants of that county:

1. Advance Sheets of Nevada Statutes.
2. Nevada Revised Statutes.
3. Nevada Administrative Code.
4. Nevada Attorney General's Opinions, beginning with the opinions given in 1980.
5. Nevada Reports, beginning with volume 87 or equivalent (i.e., Pacific Reporter).

~~—8.]~~ The bills, resolutions, daily histories, daily journals and index for the bills and resolutions of the most recent session of the Nevada Legislature.

**INFORMATIONAL STATEMENT**

1. A description of how public comment was solicited, a summary of public response, and an explanation of how other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.

Notice of Intent to File a Regulation was posted in the State Library and Archives, the Department of Cultural Affairs Director's Office, and mailed to every public library in Nevada for posting. One public comment was received in response to the proposed regulation - see #2(c).

2. The number of persons who:
  - (a) Attended each hearing: 20
  - (b) Testified at each hearing: 1
  - (c) Submitted to the agency written comments: One comment was received from Sandy Marz, Washoe County Law Librarian, who felt that the three items to be added to the list of legal materials for each county would complement existing legal materials for use by citizens and the courts. She also stated that giving counties the option of providing materials online is reasonable.

3. A description of how comment was solicited from affected businesses, a summary of their response and an explanation of how other interested persons may obtain a copy of the summary.

Notice of Intent to File a Regulation was posted in the State Library and Archives, the Department of Cultural Affairs Director's Office, and mailed to every public library in Nevada for posting. In addition, the following individuals and groups were consulted: Kathleen Harrington, Supreme Court Librarian; Sandy Marz, Washoe County Law Librarian; Statewide Library Directors Group meeting, January 2006; Nevada Law Librarians meeting, April 18, 2006; rural library directors where no law library exists and responsibility would reside with them for providing these legal materials. One public comment was received in response to the proposed regulation - see #2(c).

4. If the regulation was adopted without changing any part of the proposed regulation, a summary of the reasons for adopting the regulation without change.

No comments were received that resulted in any changes to the regulations.

5. The estimated economic effect of the adopted regulation on the businesses that it is to regulate and the public. These must be stated separately, and each case must include:

The ability to have electronic resources rather than print resources will be more cost efficient overall. Nevada county libraries may incur the following initial costs for the three new items to be purchased: Black's Law Dictionary \$64.50; Official Handbook of Legal Forms \$225.00; Nevada Civil Practice Manual, \$160.00. Costs for updating these materials may occur approximately every five years.

The public will benefit from having these resources widely available. There are no adverse effects.
