

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS**

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 630.130.

A REGULATION relating to the Board of Medical Examiners; requiring certain documents submitted to the Board to bear an original signature; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. Chapter 630 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. Any document submitted to the Board by a licensee or an applicant for a license to practice medicine, to practice as a physician assistant or to practice as a practitioner of respiratory care must bear the original signature of the licensee or applicant.

2. The Board may refuse to accept any document submitted by a licensee or an applicant that does not bear the original signature of the licensee or applicant.

3. As used in this section, “document” means any written submission, notification or communication, including, without limitation:

(a) An application for a license;

(b) A request for renewal of a license;

(c) A request for a change of status; or

(d) A notification of a change of address.
