**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS**

COMMISSION GENERAL REGULATION NUMBER 352

A REGULATION relating to wildlife to amend the regulation governing bonus point transfers to allow junior hunters with bonus points after they are no longer eligible for the junior hunt to transfer bonus points to the antlered deer category. New language to clarify the number of applications junior hunters may submit during their eligibility for the junior hunt.

Section 1. Chapter 502 of NAC is hereby amended by **adding** thereto a new section to read as follows:

Sec. 2. *Pursuant to NAC 502.063 a person eligible to apply for the junior hunt can apply a maximum of four years.*

Sec. 3. NAC 502.4189 is hereby amended to read as follows:

502.4189 1. Each applicant in a drawing for a tag for a season receives a number of additional draw numbers that is equal to the number of bonus points that he has accumulated squared, as expressed in the following equation:

$$n=b^2$$

where “n” is the number of additional draw numbers and “b” is the number of bonus points. The number of additional draw numbers determines the number of draw numbers for the species or category of the species for which the application was submitted. The applicant’s lowest randomly assigned draw number is the number used for the drawing.

2. *Except for subsection 4 b*~~(B)~~onus points accumulated by a person for a season cannot be transferred to any other person or any other season unless:

- (a) The applicant changes his state of residence;
- (b) The applicant requests in writing that the Department transfer those bonus points; and
- (c) The Department approves the request for the transfer.

↳ Bonus points transferred pursuant to this subsection apply to the same type of hunt to which they applied before the transfer.

3. The number of bonus points applicable to applications submitted by a group pursuant to NAC 502.4185 for tags to hunt deer is the quotient of the total number of points held by the members of the group divided by the number of members in the group, rounded to the nearest whole number.

4. Bonus points in the junior hunt category will automatically transfer to the antlered deer category when the hunter is no longer eligible by age for the junior hunt. Those bonus points eligible to transfer from the junior hunt category to the antlered deer category are the sum of those bonus points accumulated in the junior hunt where there was not a bonus point in the antlered deer category earned during the same year.
