

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE  
BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS**

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 501.105 and 501.181.

A REGULATION relating to water; interpreting the statutory term “water hole” for certain purposes; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Section 1.** Chapter 503 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

- 1. As used in NRS 503.660, the Commission will interpret the term “water hole” to mean:*
  - (a) A small, natural or artificially created depression in the ground in which water collects and is used or available for use by an animal as a place to drink; or*
  - (b) A guzzler or other water development.*
- 2. As used in NRS 503.660, the term “water hole” does not include a puddle or other collection of water which:*
  - (a) Forms after a rainstorm or other precipitation occurs and evaporates quickly after forming; or*
  - (b) Is sufficiently small in size or depth to allow a person to step over or walk through the puddle or collection of water.*
- 3. As used in this section, “guzzler or other water development” means any artificial or enhanced natural basin that collects or is designed to collect water for use by any wildlife.*
