

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE  
BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS**

AUTHORITY: §§1 and 2, NRS 630.299.

A REGULATION relating to physicians and related professions; prescribing the circumstances in which the Board of Medical Examiners may not enter into remediation agreements; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Section 1.** Chapter 630 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

*The Board or an investigative committee of the Board will not negotiate and the Board will not approve a remediation agreement with a person pursuant to NRS 630.299 for a violation of this chapter or chapter 630 of NRS if:*

- 1. A patient suffered serious harm or death as a result of the violation;*
- 2. The person intentionally, knowingly or recklessly committed the violation; or*
- 3. The person entered into a remediation agreement for the same or a substantially similar violation within the immediately preceding 5 years.*

**Sec. 2.** This regulation expires by limitation on June 30, 2011.
