

# PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

AUTHORITY: §§ 2, 4, and 5 NRS 706.431; AB232 passed by the 76th Session of the Nevada State Legislature.

A REGULATION relating to motor carriers; establishing varying registration cycles for the issuance of permits for Longer Combination Vehicles (LCV) issued through the Motor Carrier Division of the Department of Motor Vehicles.

**Section 1.** Chapter 706 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2, 3 and 4 of this regulation.

**Sec. 2.** *For the purposes of this section, “Divisible” means reducible or capable of being separated into smaller loads or vehicle combinations without:*

*(a) Compromising the intended use of the load or vehicles;*

*(b) Destroying the value of the load or a vehicle; or*

*(c) Requiring more than 8 hours of work, using appropriate equipment, to separate.*

**Sec. 3.** *For the purposes of this section, “Longer Combination Vehicle” means a combination of vehicles consisting of either a truck with at least one trailer or a truck-tractor with at least two trailers, with a combined length that exceeds 70 feet, and with any divisible load, legal axle weights, and a gross vehicle weight not to exceed 129,000 pounds, unless excluded in NRS 484D.615 (9).*

**Sec. 4.** *A Longer Combination Vehicle permit must be registered for a period of 12 consecutive months:*

*(a) Beginning January 1 and ending December 31; or*

*(b) Beginning April 1 and ending March 31; or*

*(c) Beginning October 1 and ending September 30.*

**Sec. 5.** This regulation becomes effective on January 1, 2012.
