**EMERGENCY REGULATION OF THE
PERSONNEL COMMISSION**

(Effective for 120 days from July 1, 2011)

**NEVADA PERSONNEL COMMISSION'S
STATEMENT OF EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Nevada Personnel Commission ("Commission") has convened this public meeting for the purpose of considering the adoption of the foregoing Emergency Regulation, which relates to compensation for working on a holiday;

WHEREAS, the Commission finds that an emergency exists insofar as:

1. The need for swift action to reduce the compensation for working on a holiday due to the statutory requirement for implement on July 1,2011 does not leave adequate time for the Commission to use the procedures mandated by Chapter 233B of the NRS for amending a permanent regulation, and

2. Pursuant to A.B. 560 of the 2011 Legislative Session, this amendment changes the rate of pay for an employee who works on a State holiday from time and one-half of the employee's normal rate of pay to the rate of the employee's normal rate of pay. Overtime worked on a State holiday will continue to be paid at the rate of time and one-half the employee's normal rate of pay.

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission hereby adopts the following Emergency Regulation which shall be effective on July 1, 2011 upon the endorsement by the Governor and filing with the Secretary of State.
