**PROPOSED TEMPORARY REGULATION OF THE
CHIROPRACTIC PHYSICIANS' BOARD OF NEVADA**

AUTHORITY: NRS 634.030 and 634.014.

A REGULATION relating to the definition of the term “precisely controlled force” as that term is used in NRS 634.014.

Section 1. NAC chapter 634 is hereby amended to add the following new language:

As used in 634.014, a “precisely controlled force” shall mean:

- 1. A thrust involving both amplitude and velocity, including but not limited to, thrusts of any combination of high or low amplitude and high or low velocities; or*
- 2. An application of a resistive movement by applying a specific force, without the use of a thrust, which is directed into a focal point of the anatomy.*
